

Gathering for the Sermon on Mount

Luke 6:17-19

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Text:

Luke 6:17-19,

17. And he came down with them, and stood in the plain, and the company of his disciples, and a great multitude of people out of all Judaea and Jerusalem, and from the sea coast of Tyre and Sidon, which came to hear him, and to be healed of their diseases;

18. And they that were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed.

19. And the whole multitude sought to touch him: for there went virtue out to him, and healed them all.

Commentary:

I. Jesus came down from the highest elevation at which the twelve apostles were appointed to a level place which was more accessible and allowed a large crowd to approach Jesus.

II. This great throng, large crowd of disciples and people from all Judea, Jerusalem and the coastal region of Tyre and Sidon gathered around Jesus.

III. The multitudes had come to:

A. hear Jesus.

B. be healed of their diseases.

C. Those who were troubled with unclean spirits were cured.

IV. All the people were trying to touch him because:

A. power was coming from Jesus.

B. the power was healing them all.

Note: Luke 6:17-19 may refer to the same occasion as presented in Matthew 5-7. However, Jesus undoubtedly taught these same principles on numerous occasions. Luke 6:17-19 may refer to another occasion on which Jesus covered the same main points as in Matthew 5-7.
